Guest Speaker Marlyn from the RAA. Marlyn welcomed all to Kurna country and paid her respect to all.

The RAA has 3 areas of focus:

- **Motor**-Year 10 & 11 student attend a day program where they re-enact a road accident. Very popular and beneficial to all students. RAA is beginning to move into preschool to educate the young students. Working with senior drivers to keep their skills current.
- **Home**-Use as scheme called Trusted Tradies which all members can use to locate the best tradies for the home in their area.
- **Travel Insurance** for all drivers both interstate and overseas travel

Currently 780,000 are members in South Australia. She noted that senior drivers were more courteous, strong law abiding and take fewer risks.

Changes in driving rules are changing and becoming more complex today. There are now more car, scooters and cyclists on the road. The road systems are becoming more complex eg South Road upgrades. Many drivers are distracted by mobile phone technology.

Marlyn led a questionnaire session for 20 min. She gave all member a press button to vote for answer. ie

- What year was the RAA started 1895, 1903, 1993? The answer was 1903.
- What speed should road users travel on left or right side of the road when there is an emergency vehicle with flashing lights? 25 km/hour
- Cyclists may now ride on the footpath.

She concluded her talk by informing all that the RAA provides a quiz on the website with a questionnaire which regularly changes.

Wendy Gaborit presented a vote of thanks and a Rotary Club of St Peters biro to Marlyn.

The evening meal was served half way through her presentation.

In early June, the AllKids maintenance team commenced excavation and site preparation on our new centre at Prek Trabaek. Our lease on our current centre in that village expires in mid-2023 so our target is to have the new facility completed well before then. The centre will provide 75 primary school students with a full curriculum, 17 secondary/high school students with IT and English programs and a kindergarten program for the many pre-school kids in the area. The project is being funded by the Rotary Australian World Community Service and is a special project of the Rotary 9510 District and sponsored by the Rotary Club of St Peter's in Adelaide.
