Helen Marshall.

Helen is the chair for the 9510 Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA). Helen was in Coonalpyn, when her husband died, she moved to Mt Barker. In Coonalpyn she was involved in many committees and joined Rotary in Mt Barker. She was there for five years then moved to Rotary Club at Blackiston. Whilst there they persuaded her to chair RYLA. She has always been interested in Rotary and the programs they offer. Her daughter became involved in RYPEN (Rotary Youth Personal Enrichment) in the country. When she came back from that she said that's when she learnt how to public speak properly and has never looked back. She is now a graduate speech pathologist. Both her children have been involved with RYPEN and RYLA, taking on leadership roles.

So what is RYLA? It's a 7 day residential program, teaching leadership to our 18 – 25 year olds. Some of our RYLA graduates go onto ROTARACT, others get involved with the program. It's interesting to watch them go through the program. They each get something different out of it. This year Helen filled the role of project manager, which isn't usual for the chair, but the person supposed to was unable to get time off work, so she stepped in.

Helen really enjoyed the experience, watching the participants bond, attempting different tasks. Her son was also one of the participants.

Clubs can support in different ways. They can sponsor an individual, sponsor a program as a host club, become a committee member or they can help by promoting the program to the public.

Mary-Anne asked, "How do people find out about RYLA?" Helen responded that most hear by word of mouth and they also use Facebook. Google RYLA 9510.

Romaine asked: "Could RYLA be a more effective pathway to becoming a Rotarian?" Helen: Rotaract seems to be the main attraction for the age range. Quite a few of our leaders go into Rotaract too. Just getting them to volunteer for your group starts a connection. It is a bit difficult to mix very young with older members. But it just lets them know Rotary is there, embedded, when they're ready.

Question: Is it predominantly female participants? Helen: Actually, it was 50/50.
