Ruth Bormann, Has worked with many of the most distinguished leaders in the musical world.

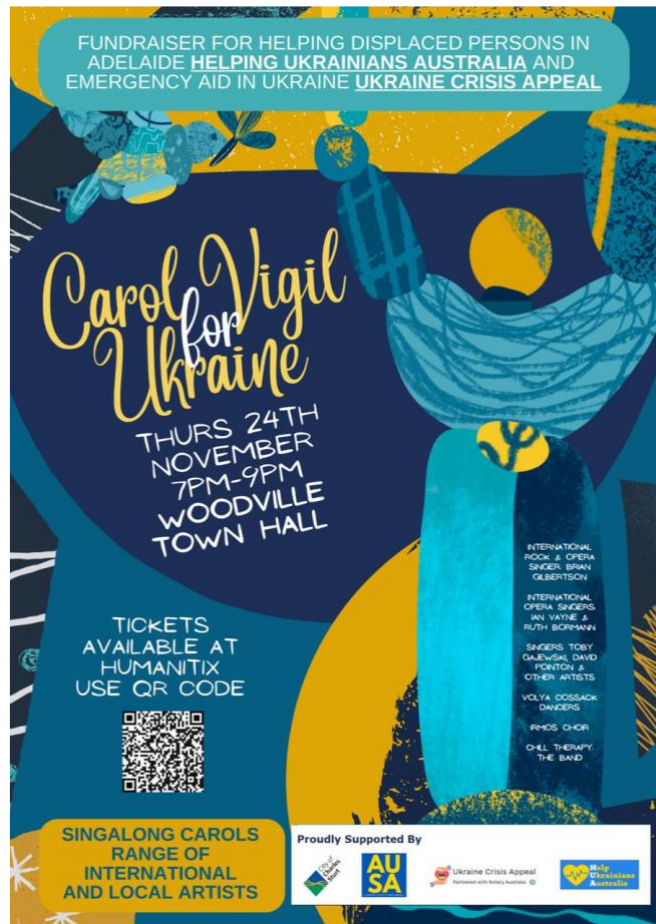
Ruth performed regularly as a guest in numerous European opera houses including the State Opera of Vienna.
