Guest Speaker – Wendy Gaborit

She began her professional life working as a social worker with children who were living in institutional care. In 1990 she took a break and went travelling with her mother for 12 weeks around America, England, Ireland, Europe and Asia.

In 1992 she married John and they worked on a property in the Adelaide hills at Rockleigh. They ran a homestay/ farmstay business for visitors. During this time Wendy became involved in Landcare and was also elected to the Mid-Murray council. They moved to Murray Bridge.

Wendy was a Rotaractor before joining the Rotary Club of Mobilong in 2005. During her time in the club she immersed herself into all Rotary activities. In 2010 she initiated a project called 'Sculpfest''.

Wendy worked for Housing SA from 1980 to 2022. She became District Governor from 2013-14 where she was instrumental in setting up Adelaide Women's Day celebrations. From 2016 to 19 she was Zone Coordinator for Public Image.

In 2021 she was awarded a OAM for her service to the community.

Wendy has loved her busy Rotary life and would never change it.

She said that Rotary is family and she has been helped by friends in her busy life.
