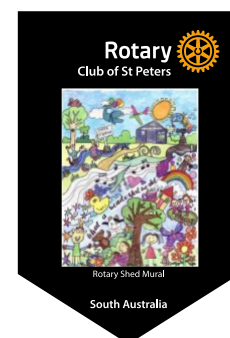
From the President – Our Club was delighted so many volunteers took the time and effort to attend our Tuesday meeting to celebrate the work of our volunteer group.

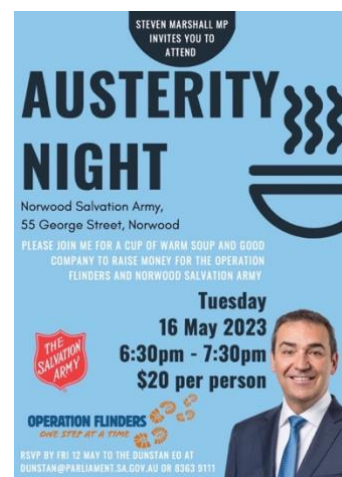
There will be no Club meetings at the Kensington Hotel for the next three weeks.

History of The Shed

Wendy Gaborit introduced **President Pam** who presented a history of the Shed.

It was in 1975 when investigations started to find a permanent place for the annual Club Jumble Sale as it was called then.

Goods were stored in various warehouses and people's back yards and had to be transported to the sale sites.

In 1978 the Club commenced a leasing agreement with the Council for the Henry St land and the Club members spent 988 hours of volunteer hours building the Shed with materials costing \$13,207.



In 1994, the Club established the Rotary Rummage Shop at the Marden Shopping Centre and eventually sales started from the Shed itself.

Ian Sando spoke about volunteering. His brother, Dr Brian Sando volunteered as a sports medicine doctor for three Olympic Games.

He was also a member of the Hindmarsh Rotary club. Ian said being a volunteer can lead to numerous other opportunities.

Grand Opening of Prek Trabaek Learning Centre!

Prek Trabaek is a small remote village in Cambodia where the closest public school is almost 20 kilometres away. The children that live in this area didn't receive any kind of formal education until AllKids began operating here.

In December 2021, AllKids opened a temporary learning centre in a rented property. In June 2022, AllKids maintenance team commenced excavation and site preparation to build our very own centre at Prek Trabaek.

In January 2023 we officially opened our very own purpose built facility, with special thanks to the Rotary Australia World Community Service, Rotary District 9510.

The new centre has 4 classrooms including a designated computer lab, 2 large outdoor undercover teaching areas, M & F bathrooms, a kitchen, and 3 hand washing stations.

Numbers have increased from 82 kids at the end of 2022 to 98 since January this year, including 5 children travelling by boat from a nearby island to attend and several others from very remote houses in the area.

As with our 3 other learning centres, AllKids offers Khmer literacy, Primary School Mathematics, English, IT, sport art and traditional dance.

In January, AllKids had the pleasure of hosting some very important guests from Australia to visit our centres.

We would like to thank the Chairman of AllKids Board - Kym Bache, Administrator - Keryn Bache, Rotary District 9510 District Governor and Project Manager - Jeff and Jenny Neale, MGA Whittles - John and Margaret George, and St Peters Rotary Club - David and Rhonda Heilbronn.
