## Report of Meeting 3271 held on Tuesday 23rd May

Club meeting # 3271 was held at St John’s Anglican Church in Halifax Street, Adelaide. The building has a long history.



The first St John’s Anglican Church was built on a half-acre block donated by Osmond Gillies, one of SA’s early founders and a flamboyant entrepreneur. The foundation stone was laid on Saturday October the 19th 1839 by Colonel George Gawler, Governor of the Province. In 1886 the existing building was condemned and the Bishop of Adelaide, George Kennion, laid the foundation stone of the current building in 1887.

It was an ideal venue to hold this year’s Music Awards because of its excellent acoustics.
