Peter told of an event with a defibrillator and its use in an emergency in his community.

Since that time defibs have been available with GPS trackers.

Greg Page from the Wiggles has set up Heart of the Nation program in conjunction with Rotary.

This program will gather information on the location of AEDs. Many units are inside buildings and not available for 24 hour use. It is recommended they be moved to a more prominent position so they are always accessible. Heart of the Nation offers weatherproof options for mounting.

It is also planned units be registered so their location can be plotted into maps on the Heart of the Nation App. Our Club has a personal USB kindly donated by the Rotary Club Of Strathalbyn with further information for members.
