Meanwhile he asks to embrace the Theme from the World President, Gordon McInally – **Create Hope in the World**.

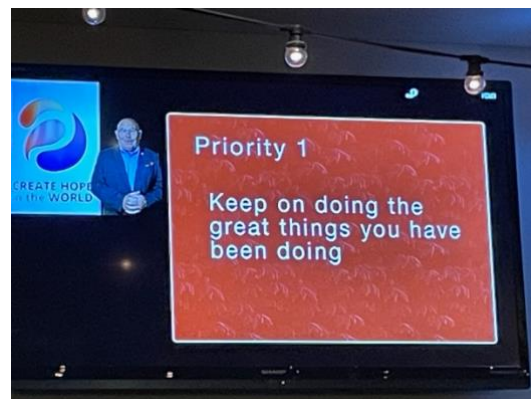
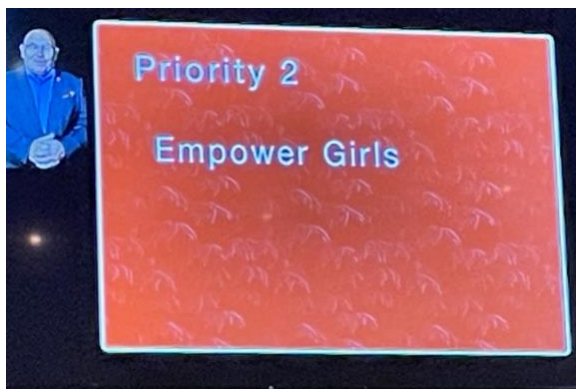


A film snippet from President Gordon gave the background to the choice of theme and the colours chosen.

This does not affect the way Clubs are operating.

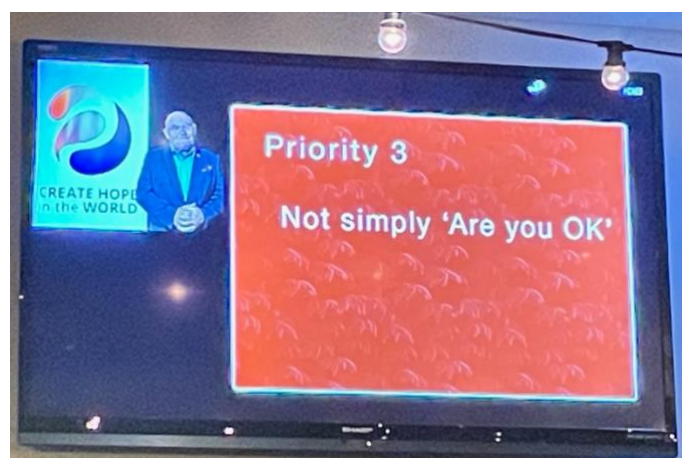
DG Craig highlighted three main priorities for the District in the year ahead:

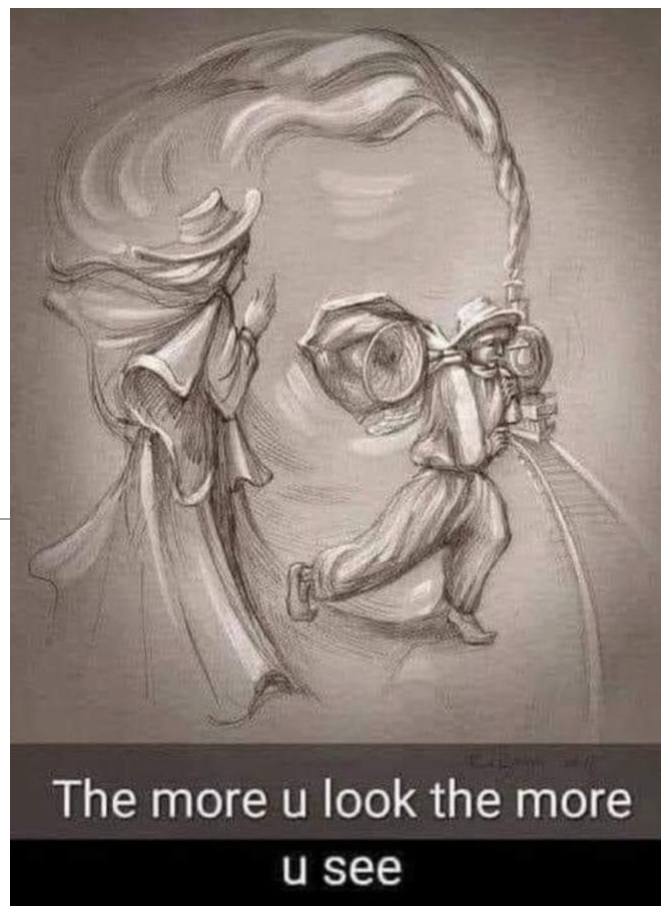
