Interplast sends teams of volunteer plastic and reconstructive surgeons, anaesthetists, nurses and allied health professionals to provide life-changing surgery and medical training in 17 countries across the Asia Pacific region.



As a founding partner, Rotary has been instrumental in the sustainability of Interplast since 1983.

Marie spoke of the wonderful work in training and mentoring support staff in countries such as Bhutan. A plastic surgeon from Bhutan has been visiting South Australia to further his skills training. Marie gave examples of successful surgeries performed throughout the Asia-Pacific region. She spoke of 27,000 life-saving operations and 8,500 training engagements over the 40 years of service.
