Marie spoke of the wonderful work in training and mentoring support staff in countries such as Bhutan. A plastic surgeon from Bhutan has been visiting South Australia to further his skills training. Marie gave examples of successful surgeries performed throughout the Asia-Pacific region. She spoke of 27,000 life-saving operations and 8,500 training engagements over the 40 years of service. The results are life changing for those concerned. The Rotary Club of St Peters is a long time supporter of Interplast.

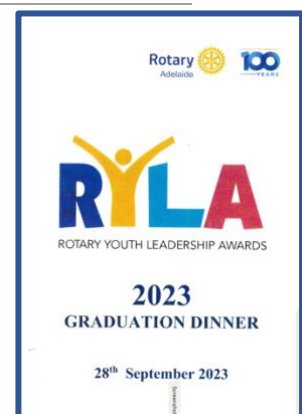
#### RYLA Dinner
