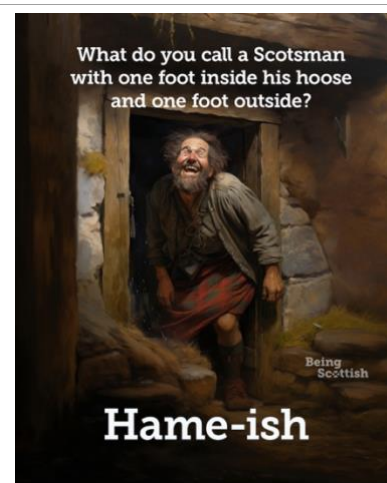

Dear Jim, Wendy, Phil and John,  
I'm safely back in Cambodia. My sincere thanks for giving me the time to speak at your club on the 5<sup>th</sup> September. I always enjoy my visits as I'm treated like an old friend. Thank you for the \$4,000 donation towards the AllKids Dental program. This has put us on track to raise the AU\$10,000 required to operate the program to June 30<sup>th</sup> 2024. We're gradually getting treatment numbers up to meet our target of 550+ in this financial year, though the condition of the children's teeth is proving a challenge as evident in the attached report. I'm pleased to see that a large % of the kids are brushing their teeth upon arrival at each centre. Once this becomes entrenched behaviour, I'm sure their oral and general health will improve greatly.

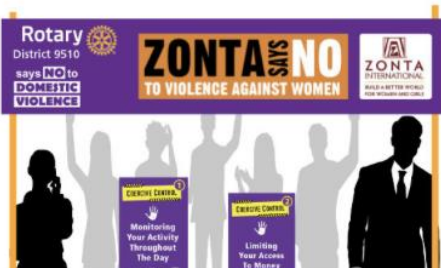

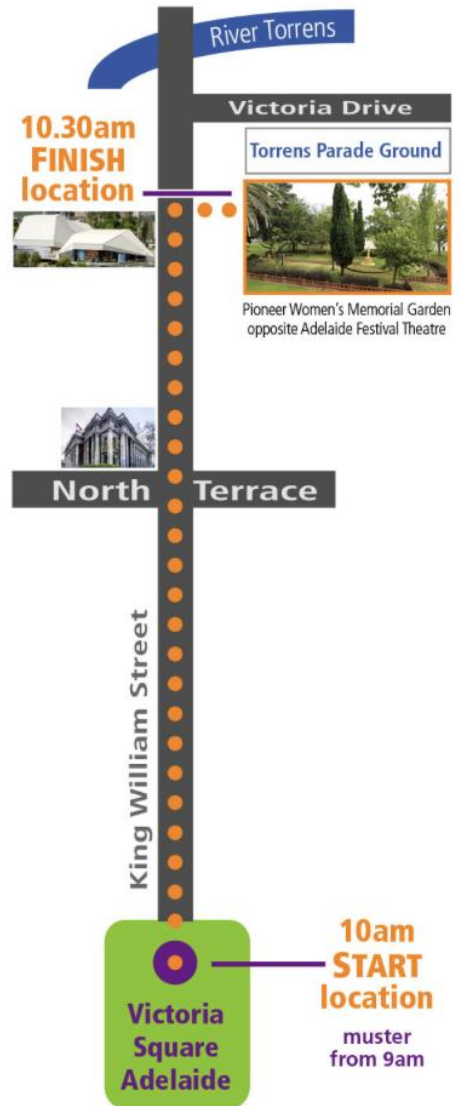
