M-I gave a very comprehensive outline of the Regionalisation journey.

As DGE M-I spoke of the way forward for Rotary in Australia. This is a pilot program.

The new structure is not expected to impact Clubs' current projects and activities.

The Role of the DG will change. Governance will change.


As a recap from the presentation these are the reasons for the change....

- From 2012 Membership in Zone 8 has steadily declined from 40,000 to 28,800 in 2021/22
- 2021/22 was the worst annual decline to date with - 5.6%
- RI Model works on numbers
 - Avg Zone size 34,000
 - District >1,100 Rotarians

- RI has recognised the current model is not working in all areas

This chart gives a snap-shot of the regional RI governance changes proposed.


