Stephanie Alexander School Kitchen Project

2022-23 The Club partnered in a District Grant with the Rotary Club of Burnside to deliver equipment to the proposed SAK garden.

In 2023-24 the school reached out for further assistance having a shortfall in funding of \$35,000, whilst we were not in the position to meet the shortfall, we did agree to see what funding could be available through Rotary international Grants and those offered through other districts. This saw us lodge an application with the Rotary Club of Balwyn who offer grants to other clubs across the zone. Unfortunately, in December we were informed our application was unsuccessful.

The status of the kitchen/Garden was reviewed by the Community Committee and a motion was put to the Club and Board to support a one off grant of \$15,000 to fund the infrastructure required to ensure the garden was viable.
