Guest Speaker – Professor Adrian Esterman



"How I became a Media Star"



Adrian writes for publications all over the world. He has been heard on radio and television throughout the pandemic and beyond bringing medical statistics to the public. Adrian has 38.8K followers on Twitter. He is a regular contributor to "The Conversation" which boasts 2.7M readers world wide.

Adrian is married to Caroline and has a very sweet chocolate poodle, Kidogo. In 2022 he joined the Rotary Club of St Peters and has quickly become an active "Shed Sales" worker.

Adrian was brought up in Essex, UK. To use his words from his bio on the UniSA website:

"After several years working as a junior clerk, I enrolled in an Honours degree in Statistics at the University of Bath, graduating in 1972. This was followed by a Masters degree in Medical Statistics at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine in 1973, supervised by Professor Peter Armitage. I then took up a Junior Research Fellowship at the University of Aberdeen medical school in late 1973 before joining the World Health Organization in 1974. I worked for 5 years at the WHO head office in Geneva, followed by 2 years at the WHO European Regional Office in Copenhagen.

In 1981 I moved to Australia and worked for many years in the South Australian Department of Health as Principal Epidemiologist."..." In 2002 I received my PhD in epidemiology from Flinders University.

At the University of South Australia, one of my main roles is to provide advice on biostatistics and epidemiology to researchers in the health and medical areas."

Adrian is pleased to pass on the following health advice concerning the continued prevalence of Covid 19:

- Vaccines stop one from becoming very ill from Covid 19
- Anyone who is over 65 or vulnerable should keep up with their vaccination schedule
- If infected see your GP a.s.a.p. and get and take antivirals without delay
