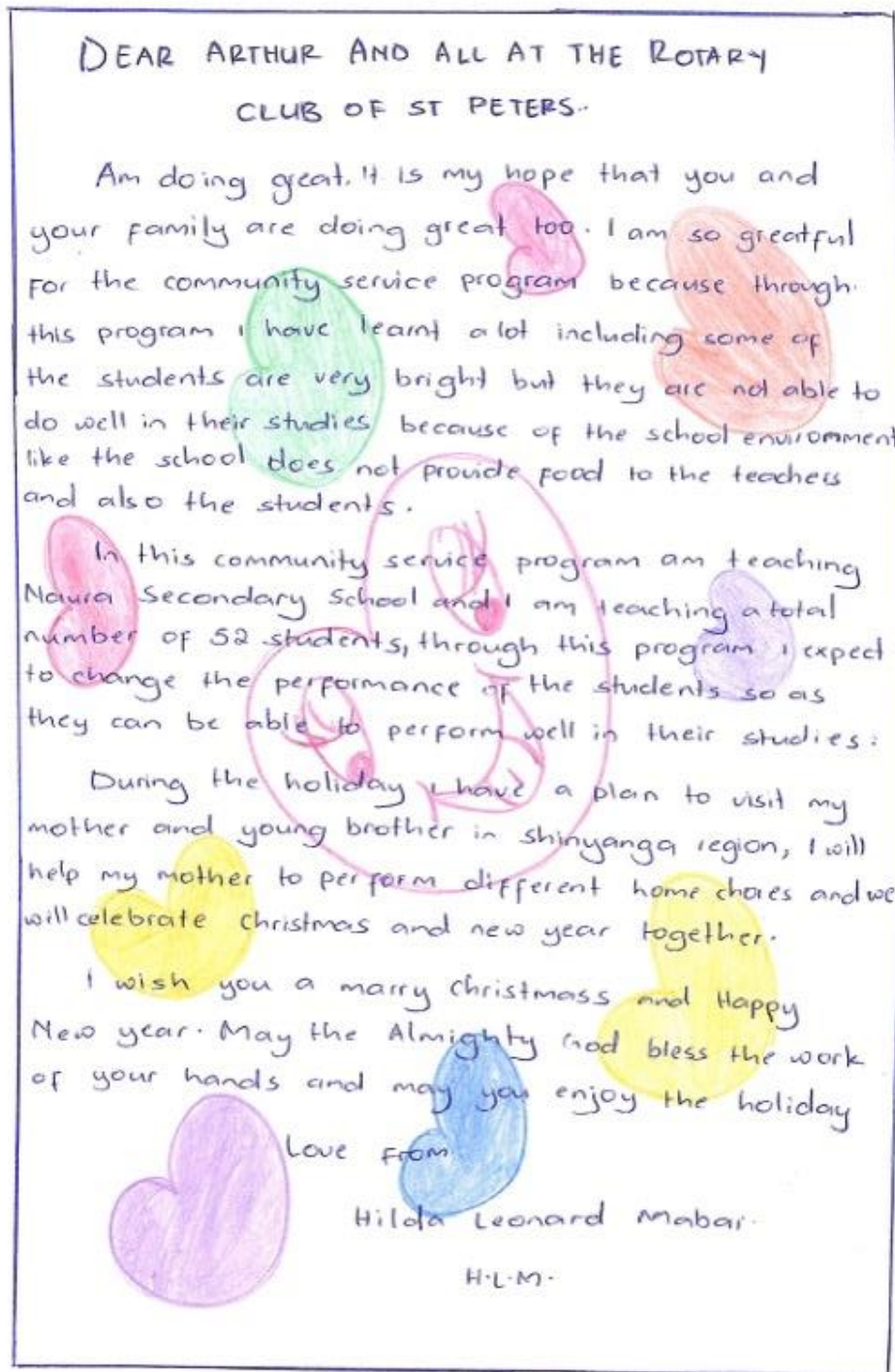
His presentation then gave us details on other stations in South Australia and Australia both AM and the FM and Digital as well as community Stations.
