Message from the Chair




ROMAC's new year is off to a promising start, with new patients and many more under review for treatment in Australia or New Zealand. Our annual goal is to treat 32 patients, and we aim to be well on our way by mid-year.

The Central ROMAC Committee, under the leadership of Central Regional Chair, Elizabeth Davis, has admirably managed the treatment of Stanric, a 17-month-old from the Solomon Islands suffering from spina bifida, with the support of the Walkerville and Burnside host clubs. This is a significant achievement, as Stanric is the first ROMAC patient to be treated in Adelaide since 2019.

Moreover, we're progressing in our management operations, having updated our By Laws last year and now preparing for a complete revision of our outdated Constitution. We're also nearing the completion of a significant upgrade to our online patient database and other management tools, as well as integrating our financial system into the system.
