The Rotary Club of St Peters has funded this Scholarship over one year.
Tristan is the third student we have funded in as many years.
The Club is delighted to meet Tristan at the beginning of his Rural Medical training.



Tristan Sprumont is based in Kadina on his fifth year as a Medical student.

In the beginning Tristan's parents met through the Rotary Student Exchange program.... In Belgium!
Tristan's mother was an exchange student and her father's family were her host family.

Lasting friendships!

Tristan completed his Secondary Schooling at Sacred Heart College. He then spent time working as a labourer and travelling – including a stint working in the APY lands. It was here Tristan saw the lack of access to health care. He saw the need for providers as both practitioners and role models.

Tristan has spent much time supporting a family member with a chronic condition that requires much hospitalisation. He feels this experience has also inspired his career choice.

So Tristan made the decision to move into Health Studies at University.
Fast forward to 2024 and Tristan is really enjoying his rural medical training.
He has particularly enjoyed working in paediatrics in Port Augusta.

Tristan said ARH scholarship has helped him financially. Not having to work every weekend for living expenses means he can give more time to study and forge networks in the rural community.... especially through sport. Soccer is a great interest.

Tristan says he has always known about the excellent work of Rotary and sees it as part of his future. The Club enjoyed meeting Tristan and looks forward to his future visit when we will hear more of his Rural Medicine Training experiences.
