Environmental Grant - East Adelaide Education Centre

Recently we distributed our final \$1000 grant to East Adelaide Education Centre. The school has had some difficulty in sourcing a second round of plants, however these have just been delivered and receipts submitted. Final plantings will begin immediately and there will be a visit to the school arranged in June to see this and take photographs.

Romaine and I also visited East Adelaide Primary to see the changes they had made. An earlier visit had made me aware of the large number of spaces where the school was intending to develop green space. Several raised beds were problematic as students were using these as shortcuts across the grounds.

Suggestions as to how this might be prevented, so that plantings have a chance of success, rejected both chicken and razor wire, and the choice was the post and rope seen in the photos. Some of these areas have now been planted with native plants, with the support of Uncle Tamaru, an Aboriginal elder.

However, there are still many more areas to tackle as the Deputy Principal, Jenn Young, showed us - and \$1000 only goes so far. We see Jenn as an enthusiastic visionary for how further progress might be made, and we pointed out the success of the Aboriginal trail at Norwood Primary that we supported as one example she could look at. I suggest that in the coming Rotary year we again provide support to keep the school on track, providing we receive a clear outline of the next steps.
