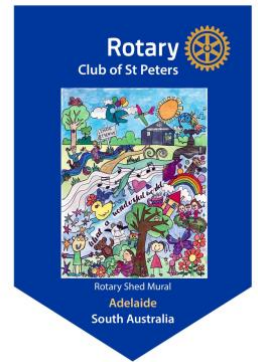

Design and Creativity Awards – as reported by *Chris Dawson*

This was the first year these awards have been fully rebranded as the Design and Creativity Awards (formerly Vocational Awards), though they followed on from the same 26 year tradition. The renaming was effected to more truly reflect the actual criteria which were used to select the student awardees.

This year five schools took part, with nine awardees in total. Together with the awardees, ten teachers and sixteen parents or grandparents attended together with a good number of St Peters Rotarians and partners, and two district representatives.

The range of student projects was amazing, and the quality magnificent. We had a flowery gown, an arcade machine, a wooden desk, a bicycle repair unit, a nutrition app, artwork and photography exhibits. While awardees were first introduced by their teacher, what was most heartening was the eloquent way in which every student explained how the work was completed, the problems faced, and the learning and satisfaction gained. Some were also able to give as good as they received during MC Arthur Manser's followup questioning.

A point made by one of the teachers was significant - that teachers and students in the Arts/Technology area are underdogs compared with the STEM areas, and that they are always fighting for recognition. We at St Peters Rotary Club provide at least some of this through these awards and the Music Awards.

Thanks to members of the Youth Committee, some of whom took on major roles in preparation for, and during, the event (you know who you are). And thanks to Arthur Manser who did a sparkling job as MC. And a special thanks to David Heilbronn who sourced a massive screen on eBay (following complaints that the previous one was too small), bought it for a pittance, and spent four hours constructing a framework support.

An enjoyable meal too, and all-in-all a great night out. *Chris Dawson*
