Fundraising Report - David Heilbronn

1. The Fundraising Committee is meeting after the Club Meeting tonight
 2. The Saturday takings were \$1587 on 4/7 and \$1317 on 11/7
 3. The Friday Crew is back to full strength with 13 people attending last Friday
 4. The Saturday Roster has a significant issue with 19 of our current members NOT replying to the invitation to volunteer
 - The few who are volunteering are being forced to be on duty every second week
 - o This is not sustainable
- Our Club budget for 2020-21 has been reduced by 25% due to the loss of trading during the Covid-19 closedown
 - Unless more of our current members volunteer for the Saturday Roster, the 25% budget reduction will probably remain
5. Our CovidSafe Plan
- Seems to be working well
 - Most of our customers are strongly supportive with few adverse comments
 - We are erring on the side of caution eg:
 - o Screens not mandatory but they are in place
 - o Recording names / mobile numbers is not mandatory (it is a recommendation)
 - o Numbers in the Shed well below our 200 limit for 400 sq. m. 4th July takings: \$1587

The Shed

Council has approved a reduction in Shed lease rates this year (due to the COVID 19 loss of fundraising sales). This represents a saving to the Club of about \$900 in total for the year.

5 clubs contributed \$25,000 in total - Campbelltown, Mawson Lakes, St Peters, Burnside, Port Pirie

240 rolls of hay came in on trucks – 1 roll will feed 100 sheep for about a week

Each farmer received about 6 rolls

Other clubs donated items eg 6 prime movers

Pam's report of the Hay Run to Yunta 11 July 2020



The cost of the hay was donated by the Rotary Clubs of Burnside, Campbelltown, Mawson Lakes, Port Pirie and St Peters from District 9510 through RAWCS. This Hay Run was coordinated by PDG Bob Cooper, partnering with Helping SA Farmers managed by Lisa and Peter Vassallo.

Jack's farm made the perfect base for us. The morning cold but the rain and wind stayed away. We inspected the trees and then drove through to Yunta. Our friends from Broken Hill (with Rotarian John Cappy and Jenny) were already there. We enjoyed a morning coffee together.

Then back to the Yunta Racetrack that was all set up for the trucks' arrival.

It was a moving sight as eight trucks arrived laden with precious hay. Their coordinated arrival was spot on.

The local folk provided a delicious lunch for us as the forklifts transferred the hay to the trucks and trailers of the 16 or so farmers.
