We provide a pick-up service for donated goods, which are sorted & stored at the shed. The Shed is open each Saturday morning from 8:30 am to 12 noon on Linde Reserve, Stepney.
- A Jumble Sale is held at the Linde Reserve, adjacent to our shed, as part of the St Peter's Fair each year.

### **Community Projects**

- We will be supporting Prison Fellowship Teen Camps & the Hutt Street Centre.
- Support for local community events including the Norwood Christmas Pageant will continue.

### **Vocational Projects**

- We have a strong association with our local schools through our very successful Pride of Workmanship Awards and our Music Awards programs.
