Our very own North Shore based AUT Millenium AUT Sport Centre – The best there is. Who else has got one in NZ?

Mike Stanley CEO came and told us about his dream come true of providing New Zealand with a centre for up and coming sports people from age 5 doing summer athletics to our Olympic gold medalists.

Mike’s involvement on the North Shore with Westlake School and rowing and rugby to start, and then Rowing Eights at Los Angeles Olympics, awarded Companion of NZ Order of Merit for services to sport in 2016, is the right person in charge of the centre for developing professional sports people.

This community based centre was started originally with Sir Graham Avery and Sir Stephen Tindall. The centre now has an \$85m aquatic centre called Sir Owen Glenn, with a 60 bed live-in accommodation and conference centre. The athletes are treated to the very best systems, environment to train in and disciplines, medical rehab and nutrition. With this NZ achieved 18 medals with 4.5 million people at the Rio Olympics. The building of sustainable systems to identify athletes makes champions in this high performance environment.

Sports science is now part of everything. Looking after peak performance, measurement of output, nutrition and psychology. This is all being done for our NZ athletes at AUT Millenium producing promising top athletes in all sports.
