DG Nominee Ian (Gov 2019-20) from Norfolk Island joined Rotary in 1986 and has held every position in his club as well as being President five times. He was born in Henderson and boarded at MAGS when his parents went to Norfolk Island in 1975. He started work in a Four Square store moving on to Freemans Bay and Milford New World. Married in 1980 they moved to Norfolk Island in 1985. They had three children one living in Australia, one in New Zealand and one in Norfolk Island.

Norfolk Island was self-governing with oversight from Australia until three years ago. They are now governed from Canberra but are not part of any state. His club has 20 members with three on the horizon. One of the younger members has just been to Ryla and is president elect. He said they have a population of about 1700 and get 300 to 700 tourists per week. Numbers are certainly down since Air New Zealand stopped direct flights.
