**Bino** said mob life had many similarities to Rotary. He was the middle child of 11 and from age 15 spent 13 years in the Mob, fighting anybody who was from a different gang. Just because that's what you did. He was interested in art and sport and always had a job. He finally realised he did not know who he was so extricated himself from the Mob. He was a carver and also used spray paint which he removed to get the picture. He was asked to help with the polystyrene sets for movies and spent 10 years doing that including working with Sir Peter Jackson on the Lord of the Rings. His oldest daughter asked for his help on the death of her partner and he had to give his speech on the Marae in English. He went to Waikato University to learn the language and finally found who he was. He said Maori were lost people so he has spent a considerable time trying to get young people out of gangs. One of the key issues is to get young people into work. He said he was lucky not to have been abused or beaten up when he was in the Mob. Over the last few years he has been supporting his partner Clare with poverty and housing issues in Nepal.
