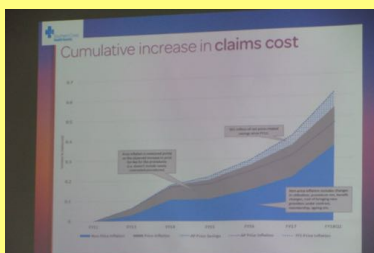

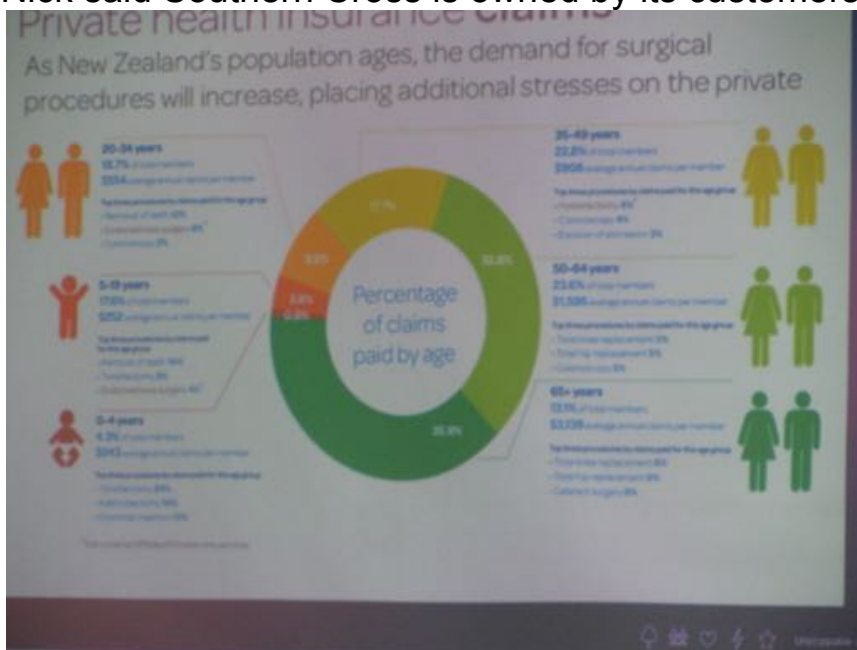
Arrangements have been made to meet them early on Sunday morning and transport them from the airport via Carol's house to Ronald McDonald House.

Nick Astwick CEO Southern Cross Health Society is a Leadership NZ trustee. He previously worked at Kiwi bank and has just returned from a family trip to Europe. Nick said Southern Cross is owned by its customers and showed us a video of how it works.



They pay out 90c for every dollar received and have had an increase of 32,000 customers this year reversing an industry wide decline in numbers. He said the profit is \$6 million but that needs to be \$30 million. He said there had been significant growth in orthopaedic and cataract operations. Southern Cross is working towards health assurance with a healthier society making smart choices. Long-term there is a need to slow growth in

expenditure. They try to provide quality at the best price. Southern Cross wants better health outcomes for all.
