Claire McCall said her father started the plumbing business of which she is now the owner and CFO. They now have 37 staff. She attended Torbay Primary when Bob was the Principal! She has been a member of Westhaven Club for 2 1/2 years. In the 90s she trekked in Nepal and went to base camp in 2010. In 2015 she did another trip. After the 7.8 earthquake she and fellow trekker Rabindra organised food, supplies and temporary shelter. Child trafficking increased but they were able to rescue a number of children. With the help of local people they built 25 corrugated iron shelters. Another trek later in 2015 saw them give out 200 first aid kits and see a number of schools operating in tents. In 2016 with Rotary help they found a builder who taught locals to build and weatherproof their houses. Over the years she has enjoyed seeing the children grow up. She founded the Himalayan Leaky Foundation to provide water and sanitation. 2017 on another trip she took books pencils etc and started an adult woman's literacy group. The latest project is the Thamdanda Integrated Water Supply which involves rebuilding and an 8 km supply pipe.
