Christine Fletcher said she had a long association and service with local groups in her area. She has a great interest in conservation and believes she can work with anybody. She said council spends a lot of time in workshops working all day with no questions and a very divided Council. Auckland has to work better with central government and get away from the left and right mentality to use the best of everybody's ideas.

John Tamihere said Auckland has 44% of the national GDP and we need is to stand up for our rights. We have maxed out the credit card and extra costs cannot be reclaimed by regressive extra rates. A clean-out is needed to cut down on waste and a culture change is needed in the CCO's. Certain things will be referred to local boards

to make decisions. Auckland will need to re-think the legislation and work with government to make this happen. Public/ private partnerships and the Superfund should be used as in Québec and Vancouver to take the pressure off rate payers. The important thing is to vote.
