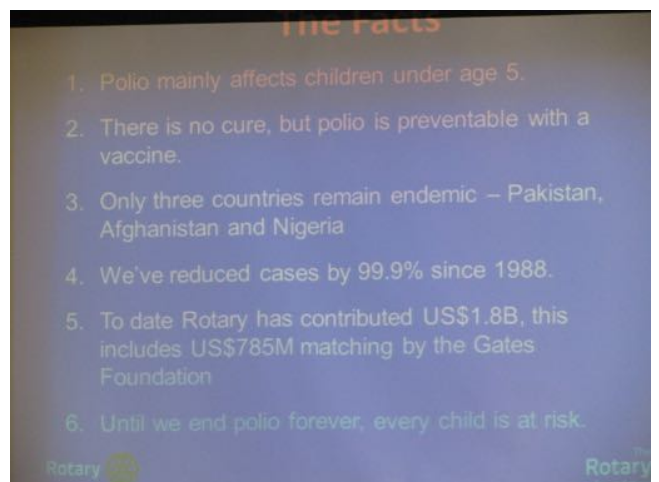
Ian says the boat trip to Motutapu will only be cancelled if there is a hurricane. Remember to take your own food and drink.

Peter told us Foundation was started just over 100 years ago and has raised over \$3 billion worldwide since that time. It has been involved with the Crippled Children's Society (now CCS Disability Action), Polio eradication, international study exchange, peacemaking group study exchange and vocational training teams.

Polio is now in only three countries and has reduced in cases from 650,000 to 27 so far this year. Nigeria is now two years without a case and will be free if it does another year. The club continues to give substantial amounts to Foundation and to Polio Plus. He
