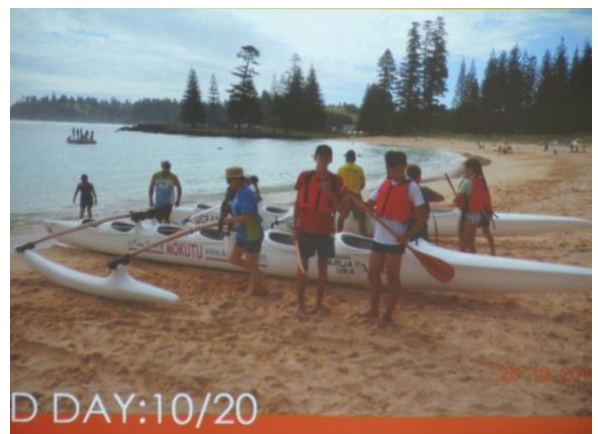

Yee-Hsien showed some slides of his time in Norfolk Island. He had a great time regular swims and much sightseeing.

Peter told us about our club's involvement in Foundation. 'Doing good in the world'. Our peace Fellowship nominee had not been successful but was very close-100 selected from 800. Global grants need to be sustainable and use partnership and leverage. Nepal water and sanitation – the club donated \$1000 as part of US\$125,000 project. This provided water supply to 5 villages and 30 toilets which had been lost in the earthquake. District grants are smaller and short term such as providing water pipes in Vanuatu. Polio – every life truly does matter. Since 1985 16 million have been saved from polio. Unfortunately due to unrest in Pakistan there have been 100 cases this year. The Gates foundation continues to give a two for one subsidy for polio donations but remember polio is only a plane trip away.
