Greg Dunning is a Rotarian and spoke to us about his kayak trip down the Mississippi River. He has been kayaking for 20 years and in 2006 did a long distance kayak in New Zealand for charity. He was able to get to the start with the help of a son-in-law is living in the States. He started from Lake Itasca. On the way from Ohio to the Gulf he passed 14 dams and 29 lochs. At the time the river had been flooded and some of the lochs were closed. He camped on the side of the river but often was able to stay in cabins or be invited into a house for the night. He identified 17 major risks and these included deer ticks, barge tows, wing dams and deepened channels, poison ivy, snakes and alligators. He received many acts of kindness but was unable to camp on islands in the river because they were covered by flooding. It was recommended not to eat the fish but at times he did. At the start mosquitos were very thick. A very interesting talk.
