Rod Smith said he had talked to Rotary clubs in New Zealand and Australia in person and on Zoom but it was not the same. A few years ago while visiting his mother-in-law he realised she was related to the Guinness family so he started investigating. Four grandsons came to New Zealand and Australia. 9 million Guinneses are consumed each day and from its 1759 start has now spread to 50 countries. Originally the essence was shipped and then bottled in each country. Draft Guinness came to New Zealand in the 70s. Production and ideas have been tempered by the Irish rebellion, two World Wars, Protestants and Catholics and the Irish Free State. Over three generations the estates went from being worth \$4 million to \$20 million to \$1.65 billion. With the bottling being done by others and no control over the market they found they were losing money so bought back into bottling themselves. Tui brewery were involved in NZ for a couple of years and then Lion Breweries in Auckland took over. There are still arguments over the taste of Guinness in various places.
