President Sean reported on the Gamble Reserve moth plant removal. In one patch they removed 300 pods and many baby plants. Another session is planned for May. There are four more patches!

Birkenhead President Jenny said she was walking in the shoes of great Rotarians like the Birkenhead President of 1971 who set up a health project which has now become "Cure Kids". New Zealand wide Rotarians raised \$250,000 which is \$3 million today. There was a health need then and there is a need now particularly to fight rheumatic heart disease. The 'End it Now' campaign aims to raise \$2million for research, vaccine development and treatment. Each year 130 people die and 1100 have open heart surgery. A rugby player with concussion was found to have a heart twice the normal size. Donations and ideas are welcome.

Hello, I hope you don't mind me writing to you out of the blue. I am part of the research team on the ROAM (Researching Osteoarthritis and Greenshell™ Mussels) Study at Massey University in Albany, Auckland. We are investigating the effects of Greenshell™ mussels and other nutritional and lifestyle factors on early signs and symptoms of osteoarthritis.
