

**Stephen de Quincey** is a social worker, counsellor and former cabinetmaker. He talked to us about mindfulness – living in the moment. The human brain is wired for negativity. Thoughts are like being in a river stuck without a rudder. You are trapped

with so much information. Our lower brain is fully developed but the upper brain takes time. Emotional intelligence connects us with others. We have no control over what happens. Your body may react to something that happened in the past e.g. being forced to eat brussel sprouts as a child. Mindfulness is an old concept which is non-judgmental and forces you to be in relationship with



yourself. You need to bring yourself back to breathe. Notice your thoughts and remember you are born in the moment. The worst critic is you. He gave an example of a city in USA where they had bought a group of people in to meditate and pray – the crime rate dropped 25%!
