- Time for a walk, then dinner













Capilano Bridge – Sat 8th July

- Then off to the Butchart Gardens










Butchart Gardens - Sun 9th July

- Lots of statues and fountains etc






Butchart Gardens - Sun 9th July

- Themed dinner @ Tiana's Restaurant














Day at sea – Tues 11th July

- Dinner @ Tritons Restaurant


















Glacier Day – Wed 12th July

■ Wow!





















Skagway – Thurs 13th July

- Sled Dog ride for Leanne & Kids

















Ketchican – Sat 15th July

- Our artwork made the big screens


















To San Francisco – Mon 17th July

- Hotel was old, but 3 full suites









San Francisco - Tues 18th July

- A little shopping for Leanne


















San Francisco – Thurs 20th July
