INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

The Rotary Club of Papakura established the Educational Trust to promote educational achievement in Papakura. Applications for Scholarships to assist young people with the costs of their tertiary education, including Trade Training, are now sought for 2018.

THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS APPLY: -

- 1.** Applicants must be under the age of 21 and have suitable ability and potential to undertake an approved course at tertiary level.
- 2.** Candidates must live in the wider Papakura Area and preferably be attending Papakura High School or Rosehill College. Applicants who live in the Area and attend other schools may be considered on the basis of their background and involvement in the Area.
- 3.** Each scholarship is valued at \$1,000. The first \$700 of the grant will be advanced on enrolment in an approved tertiary course. The balance will be paid at the end of the academic year after receipt of a satisfactory progress report.
- 4.** Applicants should show their involvement in school, cultural, sport and community activities and will be considered on the basis of both academic achievement and other activities.
- 5.** Applications shall be lodged on the official form together with appropriate supplementary information.
- 6.** Reports will be required from up to 2 referees who are closely associated with the applicant's interests and skills. The Trust may contact referees.

- 8.** Candidates may be interviewed which, if required, will be held on Thursday 26th October. Awardees will be required to speak briefly at a Rotary Club meeting in December.
