## TOURNAMENT RULES

Tee off is at midday. Shot Gun Start and aim to be back into the clubrooms by 5pm at the latest.

1. This a 4 Person Ambrose Event where each player must play at least 3 tee shots each over the 18 holes and if you played the previous shot then you cannot play the next shot except on the green where all 4 players can putt.
2. On each green there will be 2 holes and you can choose either hole to putt to plus each player can have 2 'Mulligans' (if purchased) which means you can replay your shot at no cost.
3. Prizes for nearest the pin on par 3's being 3, 8, 11 & 16
4. Prize for nearest the \$100 note on hole 16. \$5 per player.
5. Maximum Handicaps are Men 18 / Ladies 24 unless you have an official club handicap.
6. Men off white tees. Ladies off yellow tees.
7. Please complete your card with your gross score and total handicaps divided by 8 to get your nett score-these should be signed by both captains and handed into the Pro shop immediately once your round is completed. It is important you swap cards prior to tee off. You are playing in groups of 8
