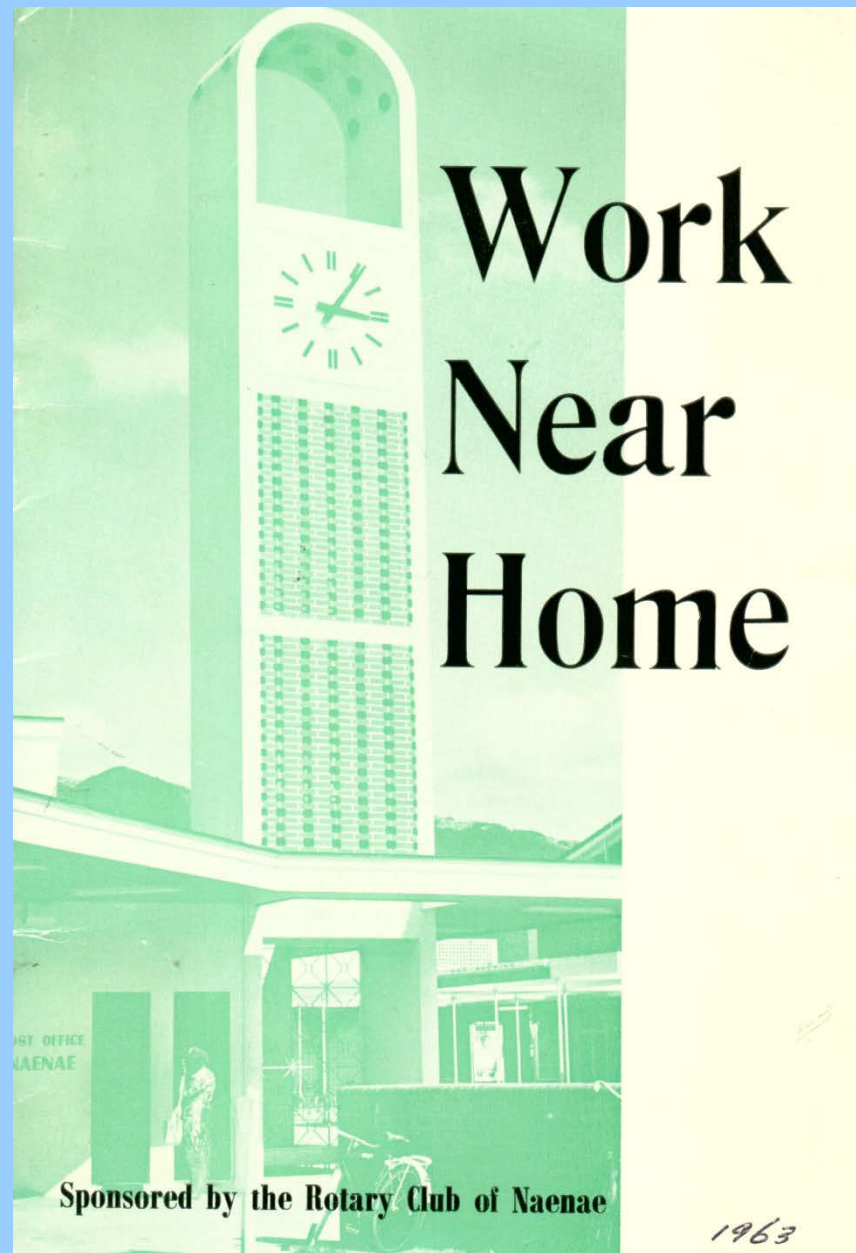

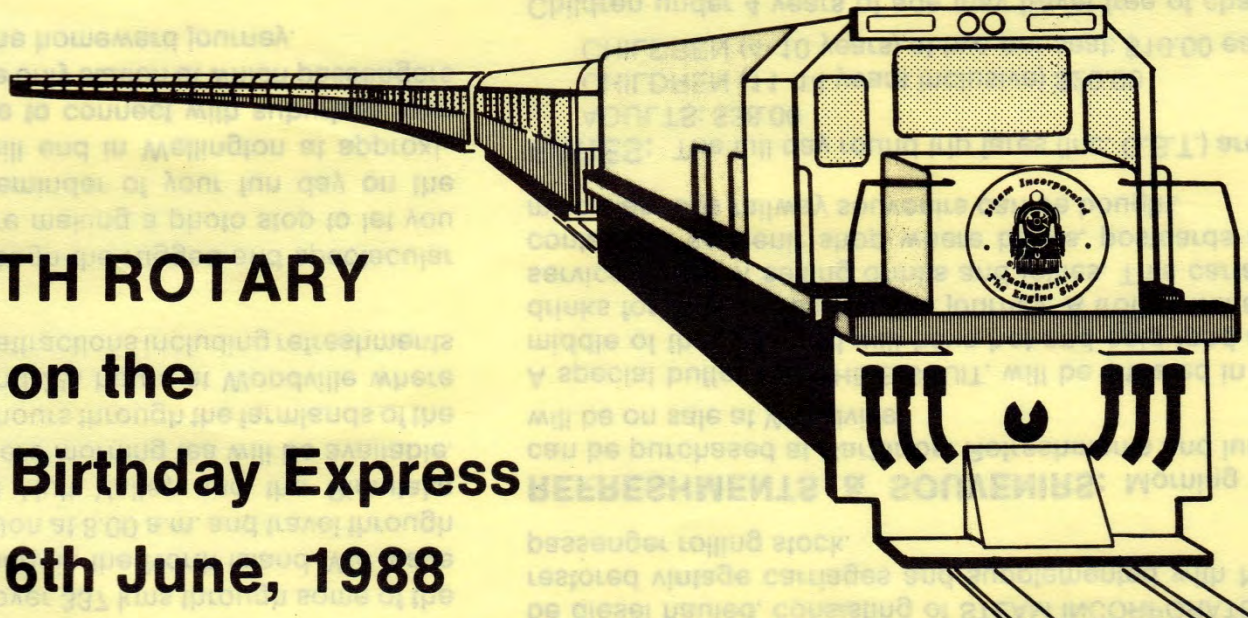

It wasn't quite wall to wall food, but a donation of \$1000 worth to Lower Hutt Foodbank last week should go a long way.

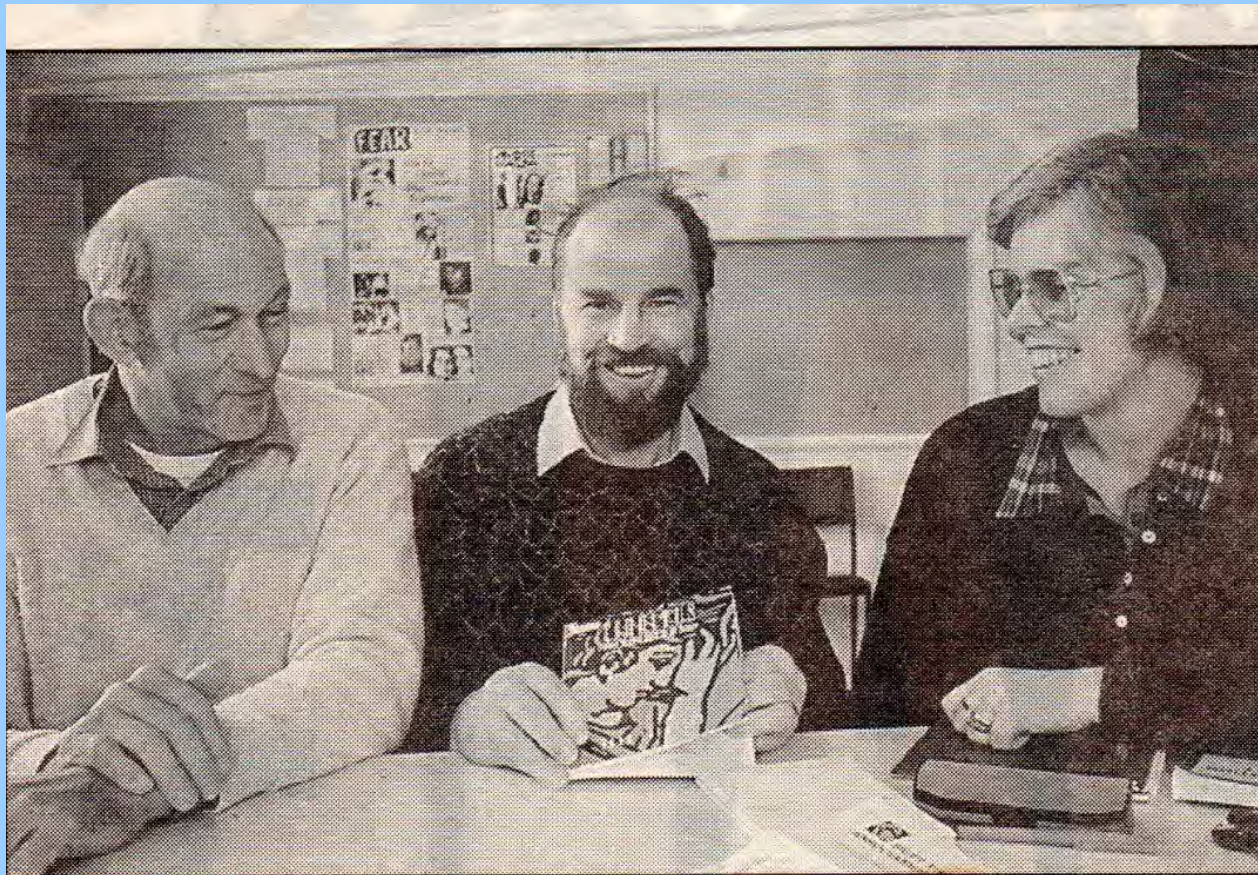

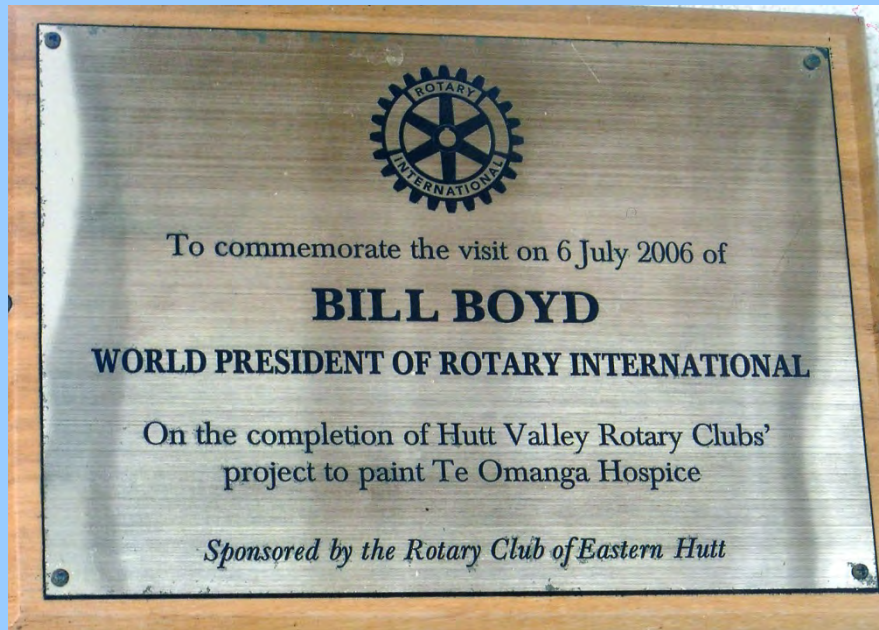
