We provide our service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, at no cost to patients and their families.

To do this the Hospice needs to raise \$3 million annually and is reliant on the community to support its service.

# TE OMANGA HOSPICE GOLF TOURNAMENT

- Fine dinning tent – help needed

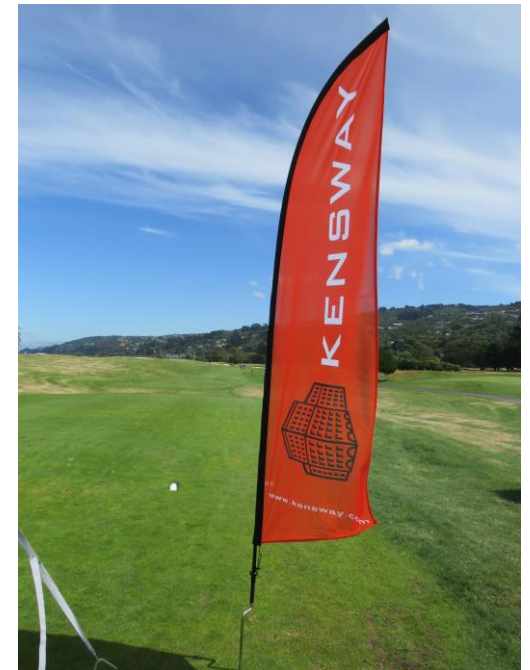

# DONATING A DAY OF CARE TO A PATIENT

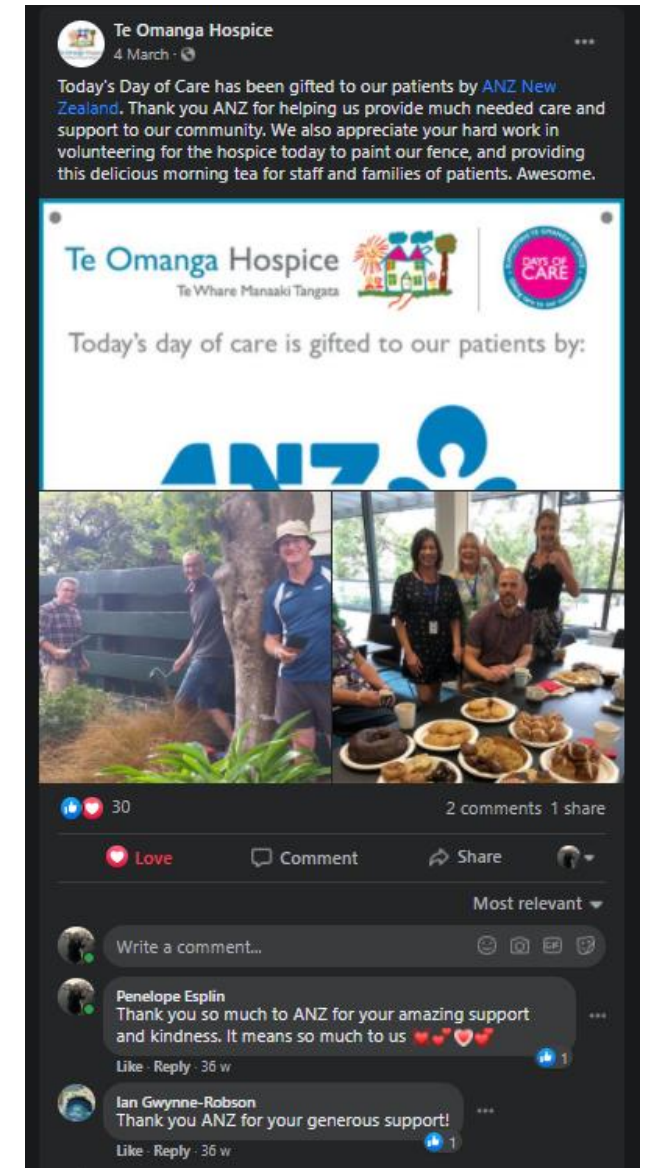
It costs \$1,500 per patient to provide a day of our specialist palliative care, free of charge for those in the community with a terminal or life limiting illness.
