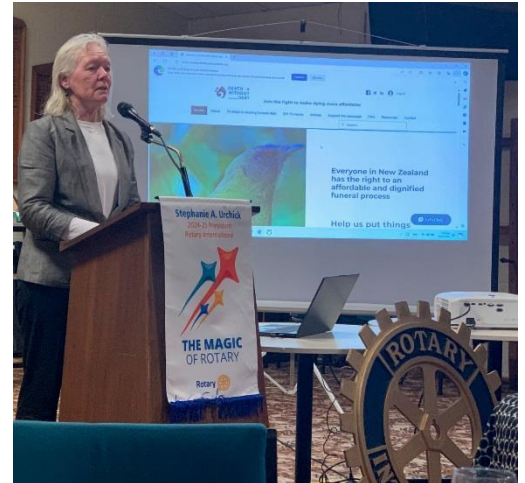

INTRODUCING ROTARY PACIFIC

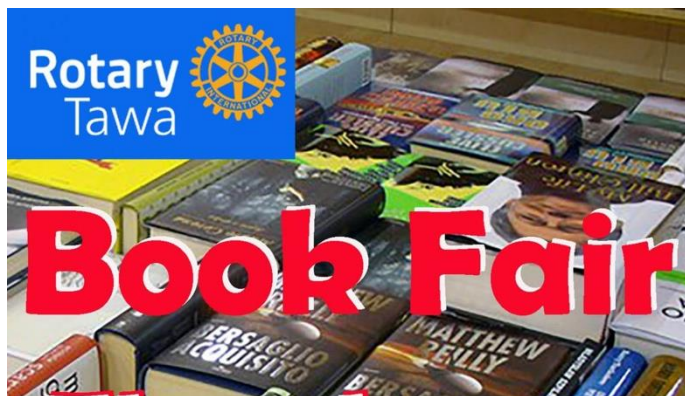
We've officially adopted the name Rotary Pacific to refer to our region of Rotary, replacing the term Zone 8.

Our new name will help us expand Rotary's public profile and create a unique regional identity.

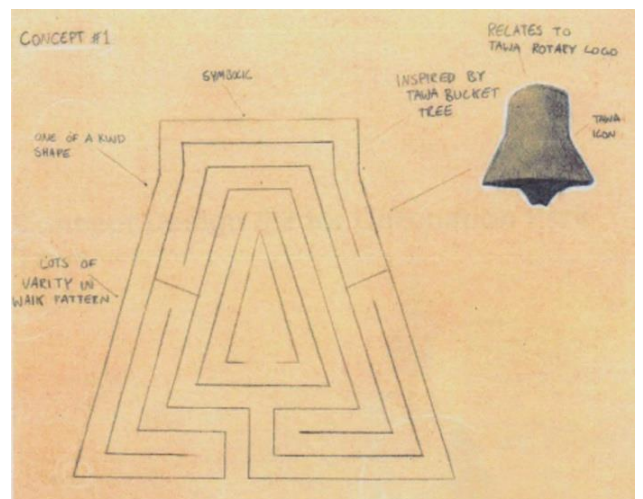
Please note, however, the term Zone 8 will still be used for internal Rotary purposes in certain circumstances.
