

TAWA COMMUNITY ANZAC COMMEMORATION



Last week's keynote speaker, Air Marshal Sir Bruce Ferguson, shared a very moving story about the nomination of then Corporal Apiata to receive a Victoria Cross for New Zealand. He received the award in 2007 for bravery under fire rescuing a wounded comrade in Afghanistan in 2004. It had been 60 years since a VC had been last awarded to a New

Zealander. In 2008, Cpl Apiata donated his VC to the NZSAS Trust to stay in NZ.



There was an excellent turnout at the Tawa community commemoration for AN ZAC Day. Thank you Elizabeth Sutton for organising the wreath; and to Philip Harland who lay the Rotary wreath at the commemoration service.


