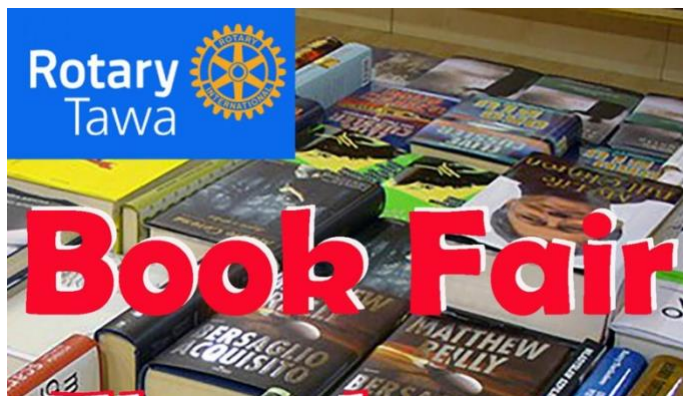
Singapore Convention Awaits

The Rotary convention is where friendship and learning come together to inspire you. In Singapore you'll connect with people of action from around the globe at Rotary's biggest event of the year.

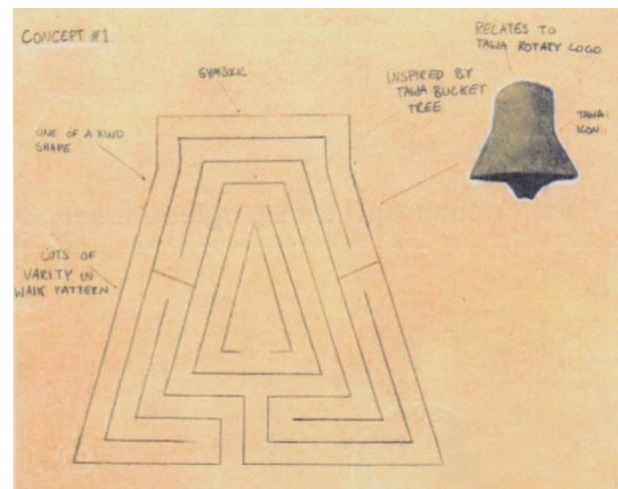
