Faberge Egg

A Faberge egg is one of the jewelled eggs made by Peter Carl Faberge and his company between 1885 and 1917.

The most famous are those made for the Russian Tsars Alexander III and Nicholas II. They were Easter gifts for their wives and mothers, and are called the Imperial Faberge eggs.

The house of Faberge made about 50 eggs, of which 43 have survived. Two more were planned for Easter 1918 but were not delivered due to the Russian Revolution.
