Our district (9980) won national awards for the highest percentage gain in membership, highest numerical gain in membership, and highest growth in new female members. Well done to us all.

Other numbers mentioned were that Rotary International has been up and running for 115 years, and is now active in 220 countries with 1.239 million members. In History This Week

- 20 October 1987 ~ Black Tuesday share market crash where billions of dollars were wiped off the value of NZ shares in the weeks following, as the shock waves of a sharp drop in New York's Wall St stock market rippled around the world.
- 22 October 1967 ~ Denny Holme become the first and so far only New Zealander to win the Formula One World Championship. In 10 seasons he had 8 victories and 33 podium finishes. He finished 3rd in 1968 and 1965.
- 23 October 1915 ~ The sinking of the transport ship Marquette in the Aegean Sea lost the lives of 167, 32 were New Zealanders including 10 NZ Army nurses.
