

In History This Week

- 7 August 1997 ~ Beatrice Faumuina wins athletics world championship gold when she threw the discuss 66.82m.
- 11 August 1962 ~ Aramoana the country's first roll-on roll-off ferry entered service between Wellington and Picton. In its first year it carried 207,000 passengers, 46,000 cars and 181,000 tonnes of cargo.
- 12 August 1816 ~ N Z's first school opens at Hohi in Bay of Islands. The building measured 10m x 6m and included an area for Maori students to sleep and a cordoned platform for teachers and Pakeha students.
