

In History This Week

- 9 September 1976 ~ The establishment of NZ's first centralised electronic database through the Wanganui Computer Centre Act focused on the state's ability to gather information about its citizens.
- 11 September 1928 ~ Australians Charles Kingsford Smith and Charles Ulm crossed the Tasman covering 2670 km in 14 hours 25 minutes, landing at Wigram.
- 13 September 1933 ~ The Labour Party's Elizabeth McCombs became NZ's first woman Member of Parliament, winning a by-election in the Lyttelton seat caused by the death of her husband James who held the seat since 1913.
