<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Club Committee nominates the Officers and elected Directors. • The Board is responsible for the running the club: administration, membership, public relations, Club projects and Rotary projects • Funds come from membership subs, sergeant's fines, the weekly raffle and other member-funded activities. • Can apply for funds from the Charitable Trust to support Club projects 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trustees are nominated by Club members and elected at the Club's Annual General Meeting • Are responsible for all funds raised for charitable purposes • Can provide funds for Club initiated projects • Can distribute funds as provided for in the Charitable Trust deed.

ELECTION OF TRUSTEES	TRUSTEES' RESPONSIBILITIES
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nominated and Elected by members of the Rotary Club of Timaru • 6 Elected Trustees , serve for 3 years (2 retire each year) • Usually 2 elected each year – all 6 this year to start things off • Nominated, seconded in writing - nominee signs to consent • Election held at the Club AGM 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Elect a Chair: appoint a secretary and treasurer • Carry out the Duties in the Trust Deed • Ensure funds are used appropriately • Trustees are legally responsible for carrying out the requirements of the Charitable Trust Deed • Report on Trust's activities to the Club, Companies Office, Charities Commission
