As discussed here is more information about the proposed Rotary branded water bottle (aluminium 750ml with sipper cap) fundraiser for the district to support the E-club of WASH and their Global grant application to rollout the WASH in Schools project in Nigeria.

Rotary clubs are working with UNICEF to develop sustainable water, sanitation, hygiene (collectively referred to as WASH), and education projects using the expertise and resources available through two of Rotary's areas of focus: basic education and literacyhttps://my.rotary.org/en/learning-reference/about-rotary/basic-education-and-literacy and water and sanitationhttps://my.rotary.org/en/learning-reference/about-rotary/water-and-sanitation.

If each club takes 50 bottles x 30 clubs x retail \$25 = \$37,500 less cost estimate \$15,000 = \$22,500 but I am sure we can do better than this! Please discuss/ distribute with your team for next year and start firming up on the number of bottles you would like your club to sell. Remember if you are having a book sale or other community event you can sell bottles there too. Why not have a sale table outside your local supermarket on OCTOBER 15 International handwashing day.

Bottles will come in box of 50, but you can buy multiple boxes. To keep our costs down each club will collect bottles from one of 4 distribution points Timaru, Cromwell, Dunedin and Invercargill – delivery target July.
