

### Rotary's Emergency Response Kits

Each year, Rotary New Zealand volunteers buy the stock and assemble hundreds of kits which are then prepositioned throughout the Pacific. The kits are ready for immediate distribution after a disaster as soon it is safe to do so. Rotary New Zealand (RNZWCS Limited) manages the process.



Since 2009, a total of 10,886 ERKs have been purchased and packed responding to eighteen devastating cyclones and flooding and one tsunami.

Prepositioned stock is stored in Auckland, Fiji (Suva, Lautoka and Labasa), Samoa, Tonga, Cook Islands and Vanuatu (Port Vila and Santo).

Rotary partners with Pacific Island governments through their National Disaster Management Organisations (NDMO) who coordinate relief efforts in each country. That way the Emergency Response Kits are distributed to those most in need.

Rotary works where appropriate with local Non-Government Organisations (NGO's) to provide transportation, personnel and volunteers to ensure the kits are distributed in a timely manner.

Stock prepositioned in the Pacific is monitored for all countries by a Rotarian appointed ERK Manager based in Fiji.



One recipient from Fiji visiting a Rotary information booth in Auckland some years later was reported to have said:

"I was not a Rotarian but when my family desperately needed help after disastrous flooding in Fiji, Rotary gave us one of these ERK's – that's why I wanted to join Rotary and became a Rotarian."

The container and contents together with storage and freight costs are valued at approximately \$600.
