We also have some amusements (we have our own Octopus), so if any of your team are interested in assisting with that (loading/unloading, our operator runs the device), I can allocate them in that zone. There is supervising activations, assisting with our monitoring of the U5s area etc. ensuring the children are sharing time on the exhibits/play items. Can bring along chairs.

We use Canterbury Weather Updates to make a call the night prior for each night, we operate in light drizzle. If heavy rain is forecast, we postpone and move all ticket holders to another night.

There is a full H&S plan for the event, we will break this down and provide you will information prior to the event and there will be a H&S briefing for the volunteers each night.
