- 5. Special Guest (8:35-9:09pm): Keith Harris from Ipswich Club, District Youth Services Chair
 - a. Impressed with the our club's energy: Came to see what the group is like. Recently became Youth Services Chair. Role is to educate us on how we fit into Rotary and how we work together. Trying to learn how he can bring our energy to Rotary Clubs. 20 years as Rotarian; wife is 10 years Rotarian. Previously Interact chair. Worked with teens. Rotary pulls everyone together.
 - b. Background Rotary information:
 - i. Founder of Rotary: Paul Harris, lawyer. In Chicago. 1904. Women included in 1987. Clubs exist in over 200 countries in the world.
 - ii. RI began vaccinated kids against Polio in 1986. Original commitment was \$100 million dollars for three years with the goal to eradicate it by the end of the three years.
 - iii. Collaborated with WHO and CDC and Rotary was the only private partner in this endeavor.

 Polio eradicated everywhere but four countries by 2004 (Pakistan, Afghanistan, Nigeria, India)
 - iv. Bill and Melinda Gates got onboard. We've raised over 1 billion dollars. B&M matched our funds.
 - v. Polio will be the only other disease wiped out (small pox)
 - c. "Rotary is an organization for change around the world. But we hate change in our own club."
 - d. "The Rotary Foundation? Have you applied to Rotary Foundation grants? If you were to come and say you had an idea, we'll try to figure out and make it happen."
 - e. Background of Boston Rotary:
 - i. 47 rotary clubs in our district; District 7930, from Boston to Amesbury
 - f. Advice: "Go to a different club! See what it's like. See what you like and don't Like and bring it back to your own club"
 - i. "Believing in what you're doing. Some Rotary Clubs may be doing things out of tradition."
 - g. "Rotary at its best."
 - h. Event: World peace and Understanding Dinner. In Lynnfield Sheraton. Celebrating world peace. Last year for this same event Keith and wife created a game, giving everyone an identity. Goal was to survive for two days. This year's event will have another interesting activity to promote awareness and educate on a specific topic.
